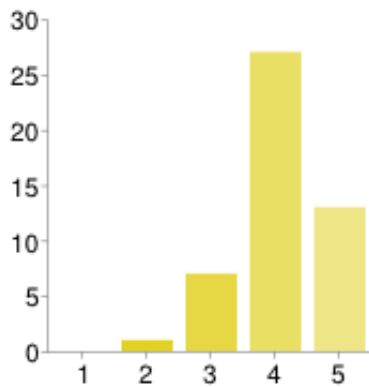

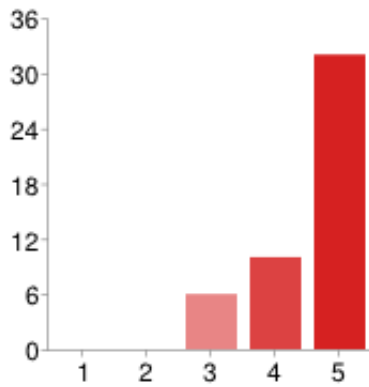

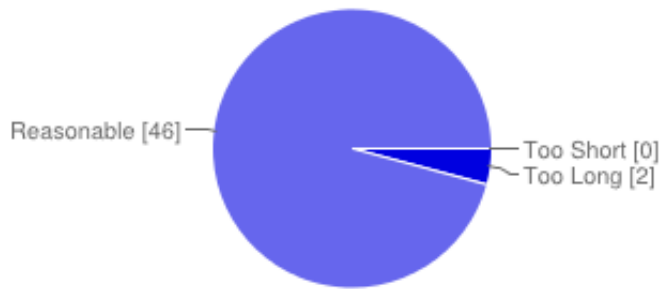
Small Group Sessions Comments

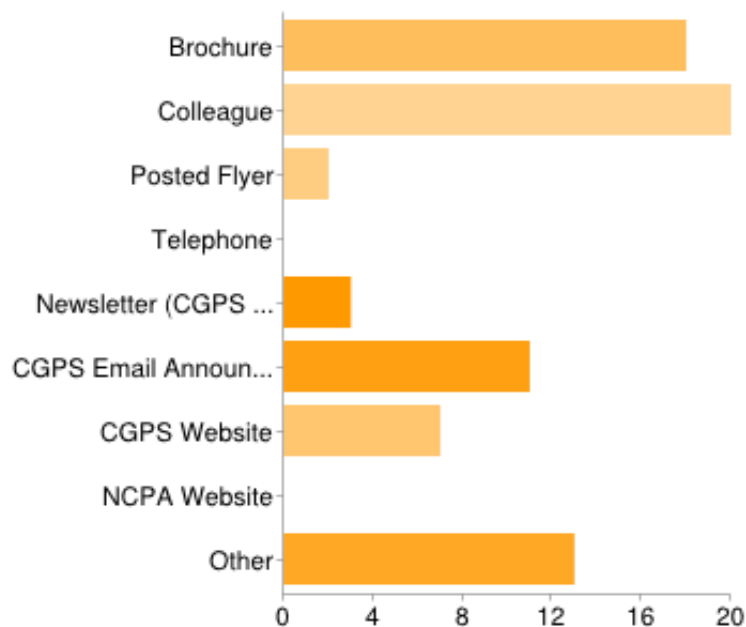

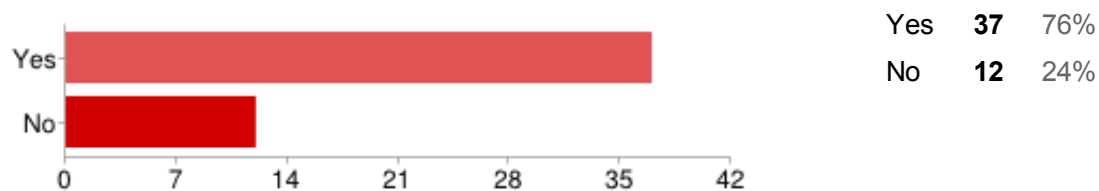

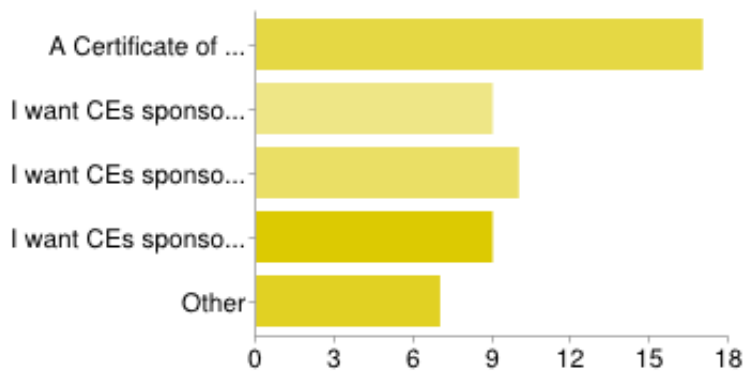
